

# TopSpin 3.\* - CodeMeter CPR Listener Port Error

**Error:** “The program tried to start up the CPR Listener on the following TCP/IP port numbers but all of them seem to be unavailable. Checked port numbers: 5650-6672”

## Troubleshooting Steps

### 1. Check for Zombie CodeMeter Process

```
ps aux | grep -i codemeter  
ps aux | grep -i wibu
```

If multiple instances are running, kill them:

```
sudo pkill -f CodeMeter  
sudo pkill -f wibu
```

Restart the CodeMeter daemon:

```
sudo /Library/CodeMeter/bin/codemetercc restart
```

### 2. Check What is Using the Ports

```
sudo lsof -i :5650-6672
```

This will identify any process squatting on the required ports.

### 3. Restart CodeMeter via launchctl

```
sudo launchctl stop com.wibu.CodeMeter.daemon  
sudo launchctl start com.wibu.CodeMeter.daemon
```

### 4. Check macOS Firewall

- Go to **System Settings → Network → Firewall → Options**
- Ensure CodeMeter is not being blocked
- Firewall prompts can be silently missed after macOS updates

## 5. Check macOS Privacy / Network Permissions

- Go to **System Settings → Privacy & Security**
- Look for CodeMeter or Wibu entries and ensure they have network access

## 6. Full Reinstall (Last Resort)

1. Uninstall TopSpin completely
2. Remove CodeMeter manually:

```
sudo rm -rf /Library/CodeMeter/  
# Also remove LaunchDaemons  
sudo rm /Library/LaunchDaemons/*codemeter*  
sudo rm /Library/LaunchDaemons/*wibu*
```

1. Reboot
2. Reinstall TopSpin fresh
